Books

The table below includes all of the books referenced in the Stolen Generations Resource Kit for Teachers and Students.

We have indicated whether these books are included in the lesson plans and for which years this applies so it is easy to see which books need to be purchased for each year level. The final column indicates which year level books have been *recommended* for. These books are not necessary for the lessons, but additional resources to embed in your school's curriculum, or to recommend to students.

We have organised the books according to two themes: Stolen Generations, and Culture & Stories. The Stolen Generations books are explicitly about the Stolen Generations, while the Culture & Stories books are about First Nations knowledges and experiences without a specific focus on the Stolen Generations.
